

Culinary Services Information Update 4-29-21





New CDC Guidelines for Communal Dining, issued April 27, 2021.

Fully vaccinated residents can participate in communal dining without use of source control (masks) or physical distancing. (*Meets the guidelines*)

If unvaccinated residents are dining in a communal area (e.g., dining room) all residents should use source control (masks) when not eating and unvaccinated resident should continue to remain at least 6 feet from others. (Does not meet guidelines).

What does this mean for Tel Hai Diners?

In all common areas and the entrance and exit to the dining rooms:

- Masks must be worn- Please make sure your nose and mouth are covered.
- Practice social distancing 6 ft.
- Use one way in, one way out.
- Check in.
- Continue use of Hand Sanitizer.
- Guests are only permitted during Lunch Service at this time.

When making your reservation, you will be asked if you and others in your reservation meet the guidelines or do not meet the guidelines for seating arrangement purposes.

Residents that Meet Guidelines:

 Maximum up to 6 persons meeting the guidelines per table. Residents <u>may be</u> from different households.

Residents that Do Not Meet Guidelines:

• Maximum of 4 persons per table. This could be up to 4 singles. Please note that 2 members of the <u>same</u> <u>household</u> may be seated with 1 or 2 persons of <u>another household</u>.
